## How do I know if I will be eligible to apply for free school meals?

- You can apply for free school meals if you are in receipt of any of the following:
- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net income of no more than £7,400).
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual household gross income that does not exceed £16,190).
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance. Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999. The guarantee element of Pension Credit. A run-on of Working Tax Credit – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
