### Leave the fidgets at home!

Fidget toys, or indeed any toys from home, should stay at home and are not permitted in school. They can also be very disruptive if children try to play with them during lesson times. If toys are in school, staff will remove them during the school day and children will be asked to bring them home at the end of the day. Please ensure that your children leave all toys at home.
