
Health and Safety

This will be a new section of our newsletter each week. Here I will share any issues which we need parents' support to keep our school community safe.

- Please could younger siblings be asked not to ride bikes on the school grounds. We had an incident earlier this week of a Junior child being hurt by an unsupervised younger sibling riding their bike across the playground. Thank you for your support with this.
- Our policy is that all jewellery (including earrings) will be removed for PE / Games / Swimming lessons. If your children are unable to remove their earrings themselves, parents must remove these either at home before school or by visiting school before the PE lessons. I have very kind staff who would do anything to help parents and children. However, I would appreciate staff not being put in the position of removing the earrings for children. This is our policy as we follow the guidance published in Safe Practice: in Physical Education, School Sport and Physical Activity which '...strongly recommends the practice of removing all personal effects at the commencement of every lesson to establish a safe working environment. This applies to all ear and body piercings, including retainer and expander earrings.'
