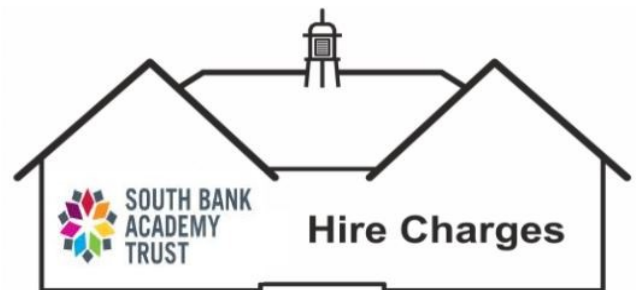


We are now taking bookings for the hire of our School Hall!
