Hello, we are the Wellbeing in Mind Team. We are a team of qualified mental health professionals who are now working in your child's school.

Carr Junior school is one of 8 education settings in York that can now access wellbeing support and advice via our new team. The focus of our work in school will be around promoting positive mental health and wellbeing and early intervention, helping to raise awareness about the common problems young people experience and how to deal with them. The team will also support the school to develop a 'whole school approach' to wellbeing. We are very passionate about helping every child be happy and healthy. We strive to do this by working with everybody from school staff to families and children themselves. We are also able to offer group work in school and we have already done a talk in an assembly about wellbeing. We are an NHS service, operated by Tees, Esk and Wear Valleys NHS Foundation Trust (TEWV).
