This week we have been focussed on Safeguarding and ensuring that we have good practice across all areas of Safeguarding and Child Protection arrangements. As this involves work across the curriculum, involves all staff, governors, systems and processes across the whole school, it has included all priorities from the School Improvement Plan. Our Safeguarding review has been really positive showing that we have many strengths in this area especially our fantastic Pastoral team. Our TAs have also attended training this week in line with Priority 2: Attainment and Progress of vulnerable groups. They have been learning how they can better support pupils with particular learning needs within particular areas of learning.
