Improving our School

This week, we have continued with our actions towards improving outcomes in Writing. Our new approach to Spellings has been launched this week. From now on the children will receive their new spelling lists on a Friday or the following Monday. The spellings will be set via Spelling Shed which the children have a log in to access. Each week the teacher will spend 3 sessions on teaching the spellings in class and the children will complete their tests on a Friday. Each week the scores from the children's tests will be added up and the class with the highest average score will get to look after our Carr Star Spellers award for the following week in their classes. Parents / carers can support their children by learning / practising the spellings as often as possible at home.
