Improving our School

This week we have been focusing on attendance and punctuality. I have monitored attendance along with Miss Annetts, who you will see at the office window and she is also our school Attendance Officer. Our overall school attendance has been positive although slightly affected by the children being back together after the Summer break and sharing the usual start of term 'bugs'. There have been some real improvements in individual attendance which is very pleasing for the start of the new term. Any families we have concerns for have been contacted. We are now using the new City of York Fast Track system which was emailed to you all last week.

Health & Safety and Safeguarding

If you have any concerns about the welfare or safety of a child, please contact the school and ask to speak to the Designated Safeguarding Lead (Mrs Vicki Kerr) or the Deputy Safeguarding Lead (Miss Daniella Harrison).

Once again, we are concerned about parking around the school entrance and the safety of children when cars are dropping children off at the school gates. Please DO NOT pull into that area in your car as it is not safe. Please also park considerably to the residents and consider parking further away on adjacent streets or up at the Co-op and then walking round to the school. This would really help to reduce the number of cars near the school entrance and would keep everyone much safer. Thank you.

Online Parents Evening

You will have received a letter today to book your 5 minute slot with the class teacher at our online parents evening on Wednesday 12th October. This first meeting of the year is a great opportunity to meet the class teacher and hear how your children have settled into their new classes. It is a quick meeting which acts as an extra to the longer, face to face parents evening which will take place in the Spring term. Don't forget that you will also receive the termly reports at the end of each term so that you know how your children are getting on regularly throughout the year. In addition to this, if you have any ongoing concerns, you can make an appointment to see the class teacher separately or arrange for a phone call. 
