Today we have had a training day in school and have been working hard with Curriculum Subject Leaders working on Priority 1 of our School Improvement Plan: Curriculum and Learning. We have spent the day looking at the theories and research which sit behind our teaching strategies, looking at how we can increase opportunities for cultural capital within our curriculum, creating an 'Opportunities Pledge' for our Carr Stars, discussing what our strengths and areas for development are, and challenging subject leaders to explain their choices for their subjects in our curriculum. Our teaching assistants have spent time working on two priorities from our School Improvement Plan: Attainment and progress of vulnerable groups, and Wellbeing. It has been a busy but really productive day!


Recommended for Y6
