Covid-19 Notices

We seem to be experiencing more cases of Covid amongst staff again and there is a significant shortage of supply teachers available. Please can I ask that you continue to bear with us as this will invariably have an impact on the in-class support your children will be receiving and there may be last minute changes to staff around school. We can only apologise for this and can assure you we are doing our absolute best in extremely challenging circumstances. Thank you for your ongoing support.

New guidance has been released this week which is focussed on 'living with Covid'. The
implications for schools are that children / staff with high temperatures and illnesses
affecting the chest, they should stay at home until they feel better. There is no
asymptomatic testing. Any adults testing positive for Covid should remain at home for 5
days and children should stay at home for 3 days and then they can return to school.

SchoolGrid

We have changed the process of ordering school meals on SchoolGrid slightly and you will now require a credit on your account or have a Direct Debit set up to be able to place orders.

Please note this does not affect your account if you are entitled to Free School Meals.

If your SchoolGrid account is not in credit or does not have a Direct Debit set up, you will no longer be able to place an order for a meal provided by the school. You can top up your account by making a card payment via your SchoolGrid account or you can set up a Direct Debit via your SchoolGrid account (if your outstanding balance is less than £16)."


We are beyond grateful to all those who have already purchased us a book from our wishlist. It has been lovely delivering the new books to the classes this week!
