### **1. Y6 Doors**

Please could those who bring pack-ups have a separate drink in their pack-up or just have a drink of water from the jugs in the dining hall at lunch. We ask that parents don't just walk into the school through the cloakroom doors in the morning as all visitors into school need to sign in through the office and be given the correct lanyard.
