At the workshops, parents were given information about the scheme we use, how it works and how they can support their children at home to make rapid progress. Resources were available for parents to take away and use with their children at home. Unfortunately, the workshops were not well attended. However, it was great to share the information and resources with one parent who told us that the support will very much help them to support their child at home.




