Geography - To study the physical and human geography of Australia with a focus on bushfires. This will include some mapwork and data handling.

DT - cams: To create mechanical systems (cams) to create moving dioramas of Australian wildlife.

Music - Living on a Prayer (rock music), tuned instruments, listening, composing and performing.

RE - Living: What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?

History - A famous historical figure: To know and understand significant aspects of history and the wider world. Mary Jackson, Katherine Johnson and Dorothy Vaughan

Music - Classroom Jazz: Jazz, tuned instruments, listening and performing. Great composer & work: Gustav Holst, The Planet Suite.

Art - Studying Picasso and Cubism. We will also look at typography and maps with a focus on drawing and sketching skills.

RE - Expressing: If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship?

History - pre-1066: To study a non-European society that provides contrasts with British history. We will study the Mayan Empire.

DT - Celebrating Culture and Seasonality: To prepare and create dishes following a recipe inspired by the Mayans (including good hygiene practices). To conduct sensory analysis of a range of existing products.

Music - Spring 1: Make You Feel My Love (pop ballad), tuned instruments, listening, composing and performing.
