



Jigsaw PSHE Autumn 2 - Celebrating Difference (Y3)

This term, the Jigsaw unit we will be covering in PSHE is 'Celebrating Difference'. This unit is concerned with respecting and valuing both similarity and difference, appreciating and celebrating uniqueness. It also encompasses anti-bullying and e-safety sessions. The 'puzzle pieces' explored are detailed below, as is the core vocabulary we will be teaching and using.

In this Puzzle (unit) the children learn that all families are different and sometimes they fall out. They learn calming strategies and a technique called 'Solve It Together'. They revisit bullying and explore how witnesses can be involved and make choices which affect the situation. They talk about the importance and potential impact of words both kind and hurtful.

Puzzle Pieces (lessons)

- 1. Families (how families are different, appreciating our families).
- 2. Family conflict (understanding that family conflicts happen, knowing ways to calm down).
- 3. Witness and feelings (knowing what it means to witness bullying, how to help someone being bullied).
- 4. Witness and solution (knowing witnesses can affect a situation, knowing how to solve a bullying situation with help).
- 5. Words that harm (recognising hurtful words and not using them).
- Celebrating difference: compliments (understanding how words affect feelings, giving and receiving compliments).

Vocabulary

Family, Loving, Caring, Safe, Connected, Difference, Special, Conflict, Solve It Together, Solutions, Resolve, Witness, Bystander, Bullying, Gay, Unkind, Feelings, Tell, Consequences, Hurtful, Compliment, Unique.
