

We expect all children in Y3 and Y4 to be brought to school / collected from school by an adult or older responsible sibling (not in Y5 or Y6). Children in Y5 and Y6 may walk to / from school on their own. Please inform the class teacher that they are able to do this via the planner.

Uniform

We will be continuing with the same uniform expectations as this year. Therefore, there are uniform expectations for Non-PE days and PE days. Class teachers will inform parents at the start of the term via their Year Group Newsletter as to which days will be PE days for each class.

Please note that there will be strict expectations that children are wearing the correct uniform on both Non-PE days and PE days. Please see the lists below. We recently changed our school logo. We do not expect all children to have jumpers or cardigans with the new logos on and we are happy for the children to continue wearing the old logo until they grow out of them.

School meals

Please ensure that you have booked your child a hot dinner on SchoolGrid by 8:55am each day. Teachers will check if children have a meal booked or require one booking each morning. Hot dinners will be paid for, in advance, by SchoolGrid ONLY at a cost of £2.60 a day and £13.00 a week (see office staff for help with SchoolGrid). If hot meals have not been booked, your child will have the option to book one each morning in their classroom. If your child forgets to book one in the classroom during morning registration and needs to be added at lunchtime, they will only be given the option of a jacket potato.

Please ensure that food provided in pack-ups does **NOT CONTAIN NUTS** and seeds. We have children across the school who suffer with severe nut allergies so please help us to keep them safe, this includes chocolate spreads which contain nuts.

We sell snacks at morning playtime at 'Snack Stop'. Our Y6 leaders will sell these on each playground. These cost 25p each. Alternatively, you may send a healthy snack for your child to eat at playtime.

Carr Den

This is our Before and After School Club childcare provision. We provide wrap around care for families from 7:30 am to 5:55 pm every day during term time. We have now increased capacity and can offer more places or places can be booked on a short notice, ad hoc basis on ParentPay. Information is available on our <u>website</u>.

Please note that we have a second Breakfast club option at the Carr Den: families can pay for an 8.15am start including a piece of toast for £2.

What should the children bring to school?

- A book bag or rucksack to carry their planner and reading book every day
- A full, labelled water bottle
- A suitable coat for the weather

No stationary will be needed.

Mobile phones are strictly forbidden in school. If there is a reason your child needs to bring a phone, it should be delivered to the office at the start of the school day, named and collected at the end of the school day. There is also a form which will need to be completed by parents. Any phones which have not been given in at the office, will be confiscated and will only be returned when collected by the parent from the school office.

Homework expectations

Reading - We insist that children **read at home** as **many times as possible** during the week and no less than 3 times. Please sign the planner with pages read and children will show this to the class teacher each morning. They will then move up the class reading chart. If children have not read 3 times at home during the week, the teachers will ask children to spend some of their break times reading.

Times Tables - Your child will have a **TT Rockstars** login. We expect them to play games on this on the 'Sessions' section at least **3 times** each week. If they are unable to go on TT at home, they should attend TT Rockstars club - available almost everyday at lunch time.

Spellings - Your child will have a Spelling Shed login. They can play games on here at home as well as in school. They will also bring home a weekly spelling list. Please practise these at home. Teachers will aim to mark spellings on the same day as the test is given but sometimes this is not possible.

Knowledge Organisers - Your child will bring home a Knowledge Organiser for each Big Idea which will link to their Learning Adventure. These will be full of facts / appropriate vocabulary that we would like the children to learn and remember. Please look at these with your children and encourage them to learn the facts. You could even test each other at home!

Things to look forward to!

We have so much to look forward to next year again. As an enhancement to our broad and balanced curriculum offer we also have 'Wellbeing Wednesday'. Each half term, a different year group will get the opportunity to choose 2 options from a range of 5 or 6 activities. These activities include Drama, Cookery, Multi-Sports, Craft, and Games. All classes will also get the opportunity to join a Forest Schools expert once per term in our ever developing Forest Schools area. These sessions will be linked to the Big Ideas and Learning Adventures. We will all be going to see a Panto at Christmas which I can't wait for. We will also be repeating our much loved Wellbeing Week. We are also expecting delivery of our long awaited Bookend Cottage library bus at the beginning of the school year!
