Transfer to Secondary School in September 2022

By 31 October 2021, you will need to apply for a school place for your child to start secondary school in September 2022. The first step in this process is to take part in engagement opportunities provided by secondary schools, such as Open Evenings, before making an application. It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to check the catchment area for your address. Please note that your closest school may not be your catchment school. School catchment areas can be checked at www.york.gov.uk/schoolcatchmentareas or you can contact the School Admissions Team.

Applications can be accepted until the final day, and there is no benefit to applying earlier. You can name up to 5 preferences of school, and we strongly recommend that one of these schools is your catchment school, even if it is your final preference.

Please note that the school your child currently attends will not be taken into consideration when prioritising applications unless this is specifically stated in that school's admissions policy or oversubscription criteria.

If applying for a school on the basis of your religion or belief, you will need to complete an additional application form and return this to the school directly. All applicants must apply to the City of York Council as their home local authority.

You will receive the results of your application on the National Offer Day, 01 March 2022. Please note that if you are successful in obtaining a place for one of your children at a school, this does not mean that places can be guaranteed for their siblings either currently or at a later date.
