## Visit to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park, Doncaster on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022

We have arranged for Year 4 to visit the Yorkshire Wildlife Park, in Doncaster on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July. We are planning an exciting and interesting day in which the children will learn about a variety of animals in a safe environment.

To enable the children to get the most from the day, we will leave school at 9:00am and arrive back at 3:15pm, traffic permitting. To allow us to leave promptly, children need to be at school for 8:45am.

Your child **MUST** be appropriately dressed, in school uniform and footwear. Various activities will involve sitting or kneeling outdoors. They should be prepared for all weather conditions.

- If the weather has recently been wet, or it is likely to rain, please make sure your child brings a waterproof coat and footwear (e.g. walking boots or wellies). In drier conditions, strong shoes or trainers will be adequate.
- Children should **NOT** wear flip-flops, sandals, or pump style shoes.
- As the British weather is very unpredictable, it is advised for your child to wear layers of clothing. Layers mean children can be comfortable in warm and cool conditions.
- In hot sunny conditions, please allow your child to bring a sun-hat, apply sun cream to them before they come to school, send them with sun cream and plenty of water. They may be exposed for much of the day and therefore need to be protected. An attempt will be made to use shady areas where practical.

Please ensure your child has a packed lunch and a non-fizzy drink, (carton or plastic bottle only please.) If your child is eligible for a free school meal and would like a school packed lunch, please book this option on school grid by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July. No sweets are allowed on the visit.

Cameras may be taken, but the children will be responsible for them at all times. Cameras on phones or tablets are not acceptable, so please do **NOT** send your child with a mobile phone or tablet.
