


Health & Safety and Safeguarding

- Please could we ask parents to supervise younger siblings on the field when collecting older children. We have noticed that some children are pulling on our goal posts and breaking them. Thank you.




Attendance

child later wishes they'd ordered one once they see everyone's Hoodies, unfortunately it will


be too late! So please don't miss out.
