

Year 3 Summer Newsletter - Investigating North Yorkshire

As part of our whole school Big Idea 'Where in the World?', Year 3's new Learning Adventure for the summer term is 'Investigating North Yorkshire'. We will be focussing on where we live, and how the physical and human geographical features differ in North Yorkshire.

Geography

We will be learning where we live in North Yorkshire and identifying the main towns and cities within the county. We will also be looking at the human and physical geographical features within North Yorkshire and how these have changed over time. We will even be identifying some of the challenges of living in Yorkshire in regard to environmental issues.

PSHCE

Following the school-wide approach and using Jigsaw resources, we will be looking at friendships and what makes a good friend.

We will also be focussing on 'changing me' where we look at the changes that will happen to the outside and inside of our bodies and how we can ask for help if we are worried about change.
