Dear Parents / Carers,

For the **Summer** term, the Year 4 teachers have arranged an exciting trip to Murton Farm Park, York. **The trip will be taking place on Wednesday 12th (4A) and Thursday 13th (4CG) of June 2024.**

This is a great opportunity for the children to participate in a day of interesting and engaging Viking themed activities.

When we arrive at Murton Park, the children will be treated as new settlers, getting dressed in their Viking costumes for the day. They will learn about who the Vikings were and what life was like in Viking Britain before being taken to their new homes in the Viking settlement where they will experience first-hand the daily life of a Viking family. Taking part in activities such as grinding wheat, weapons training (with dummy weapons), guard duty, pottery, farming and housework.

On the day of the trip, the children must arrive at school in suitable, comfortable clothes, ensuring they are wearing strong shoes (as areas of the Viking village can be muddy and uneven). The children will also require a packed lunch with a non-fizzy drink. We will be travelling to and from Murton Farm by coach, please ensure any children who require travel sickness tablets have taken them before arriving at school. The activities will take place from 10am to 2.30pm therefore we will be arriving back at approximately 3.00pm.

The cost of the trip is £31 - This includes our Viking experience day and coach travel to and from Murton. If you would like your child to attend, please pay via ParentPay by Monday 3rd of June. Please be aware that you do not have to pay for the trip in full immediately, you may pay in instalments through ParentPay as long as the full amount is paid by the date above. If you would like to pay for another child to attend, please come and speak to a member of the office team and they will be able to arrange this for you. If we do not receive sufficient funds, the event will not be able to go ahead.
