Kingswood Residential Visit - 2nd - 4th July 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our residential visit to Kingswood is fast approaching!

On the morning of Wednesday 2nd July 2025, the children should arrive at school at **9:15am** wearing clothes that are suitable for outdoor activities. They should have a bag or suitcase with their belongings in for the three days and a small backpack with their packed lunch, bottle of water, waterproofs, hat and suncream in. The children will enter school through reception and head into the hall. Please do not bring Kingswood children into school until a member of Year 5 staff advises you to do so, as the reception area can be very busy in the mornings and we want the smoothest possible start to the experience for the children.

Listed below is the suggested kit list.

Clothes:

- 5 x underwear
- 5 x (at least) pairs of socks
- 3 x t-shirt/long-sleeved tops
- 3 x fleece/jumper
- 3 x trousers (joggers are ideal. Jeans are not suitable for the activities)
- Pyjamas (ideally long/warm for the adventure lodges)
- Waterproof coat
- Hat, scarf and gloves (it can get chilly and the weather is never guaranteed!)
- Casual clothes for the evening
- Indoor shoes/slippers (sensible ones no flip flops or sliders)
- Wellies/walking boots
- Trainers (shoes will need to be fully enclosed even if it is hot)

Please be aware that many activities require long sleeves and long trousers, even if it is hot. Clothes will get very dirty and, depending on the weather, very wet so the older the clothes, the better. Please don't go out and buy expensive clothes! All clothing should be clearly named.





Other:

- Wash kit (shampoo, soap/shower gel, toothbrush, toothpaste, roll on deodorant)
- Towel (big enough to wrap around themselves after a shower)
- Carrier bag for dirty washing.
- Refillable plastic water bottle (clearly named)
- Named wallet/purse containing no more than £10 for a souvenir.
- Please send money in change rather than notes.
- Cameras (disposable are the best)
- Small backpack to carry their day-to-day bits and pieces in.
- Hair bands (long hair must be tied back for the activities)
- Teddy (optional)
- Sun cream (let's be optimistic it will be July!)

Do <u>NOT</u> bring mobile phones, electronic devices, expensive cameras, aerosols of any kind or make-up.

Below is a list of activities that we will be doing at the centre. Outdoor activities are subject to change due to weather conditions but we are hoping to do the activities timetabled.

When we arrive at the centre, the children will need to make their own beds and put their bedding on so please feel free to let them practise at home over the next couple of weeks!

Any medication that we will need to administer to your child will need to have a set of forms completed. These can be collected from the office, and a separate set of forms is required for each medication.

On Friday 4th July, we will return to school at approximately 2:45pm (updates will be posted on X). Please come to the hall to collect your child and you can collect any siblings at the same time.
