Mighty Mountain Climbers



As part of our whole school Big Idea 'Where in the World?, Year 4's Learning Adventure is 'Mighty Mountain Climbers'. We will be learning about the mountains of the UK, how these were formed and how they are used by people.

Science

We will be investigating Living Things and their Habitats. We will be looking at grouping and identifying animals depending on their features.

Reading

It is expected that your child reads at home at least 3 times a week. If they do not read at home, they may be asked to stay in at playtime to read with an adult. Spellings

Spellings will be handed out on a Friday and the children will be tested on them the following Friday . Please practice these with your children at home. If this is not completed they will be asked to stay in at playtime to complete it.

Times tables

Your child will be tested on their times tables regularly in school. Children are expected to practice their times tables on TT Rockstars at least 3 times a week. If they cannot access this at home, they can come to one of the clubs on a lunchtime.

Knowledge organisers

Knowledge organisers will be sent home at the beginning of each new topic. Please look through these with your children and challenge each other to learn the facts and key information on them.
