Dear Parents/Guardians,

Monday 12<sup>th</sup> May is the start of SATs week. We hope your children are feeling prepared but not overwhelmed and it really is nearly over! Please can you ensure that the children have a good night sleep prior to each day so they are fresh and ready to do their best.

**Breakfast**

On Monday - Thursday of SATs week we open the school canteen for all children at 8:15am and have some breakfast ready for them. This is as much about getting the children into school with their friends as it is about breakfast. We have found that if any children do have any nerves in the morning, the breakfast experience is good at calming them down. <b><u>Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May</u></b> <b>Maths</b>	AM - Reasoning 2
