This term in PE We will be improving our throwing, catching and striking skills with cricket and rounders. PE will continue to be on **Tuesday** and **Wednesday**.


PSHE

Reading

It is expected that your child reads at home at least 3 times a week. If they do not read at home, they may be asked to stay in at playtime to read with an adult. Please could we ask for your support in encouraging your child to spend 15 minutes three times a week at home on Reading Plus to continue making further progress.

Spellings

Spellings will be handed out on a Monday and the children will be tested on a Friday. Please practice these with your children at home. Children are expected to practice their spellings on Spelling Shed at least 3 times a week. If they cannot access this at home, they can come to one of the clubs on a lunchtime.

Times tables

Your child will be tested on their times tables regularly in school. Children are expected to practice their times tables on TT Rockstars at least 3 times a week. If they cannot access this at home, they can come to one of the clubs on a lunchtime.

Knowledge organisers
