## **End of Year Assessments**

In Years 3, 4 and 5 the children are starting to complete their end of year assessments next week. It is vital that children attend school so that they can take their tests at the same time as their peers. We know that children tend to do better when they take tests alongside their friends rather than having to catch up after returning from absences. The teachers have thought very carefully about how they can support children to do their very best during the assessments so please consider this next week. Thank you for your support. The information about how your children have performed in their assessments will be included in their End of Year Reports.

## Changes to Free School Meals

The criteria for being eligible for Free School Meals for your children has now changed so that many more families should benefit. Any family in receipt of Universal Credit should now be able to apply. When a family are successful in getting Free School Meals, not only do your children get a free hot dinner each day, but the school also benefits from extra funding which goes towards vital resources such as our staff, IT and other equipment. It is well worth a try so if you think you may be eligible, please get in touch with us at the school office.

## School and Home working together!

- Please be aware when contacting the school office at the end of the school day that it is extremely busy. This means that we aren't always able to answer phone calls immediately as we are seeing children out, sorting after school clubs / provisions and dealing with parent queries. If parents / carers need a message passing to their children, please endeavour to contact us by 3pm so that we have time to get the message to classes. We understand that there will be exceptions and emergencies where this can't be done but please could we try this in most cases. Thank you.
- We ask that children only bring water in the water bottles they keep in their classrooms. They are allowed to bring juice to have with a packed lunch but not to have in their classrooms.

Thank you in advance for your support. I believe that families and schools that work together, succeed together, and so I am looking forward to the year ahead.

These tickets are available to book via parentpay or cash at the office – please note an adult ticket **MUST** be purchased with children's tickets.

To purchase via parentpay, please put the quantity as '1' and then the total of the amount of tickets you are purchasing (e.g. 1 adult and 2 children = £14.50) and then add a note in the notes section to say what tickets you would like.



## Attend to Achieve!

Attendance at school is crucial to success. Attending school, on time, is the most important action children take in order to make excellent progress and achieve their full potential.

Attendance matters and every day counts. Our school target for attendance is 96%. If you need to report an absence or need support with your child's attendance, please contact our school office. We have an Attendance Officer (Miss Annetts) in our admin team and a Pastoral Lead (Miss Harrison) who can support you with your concerns alongside the class teachers.

There is a new scheme called Pharmacy First which allows parents to take children to the pharmacy with some illnesses rather than booking or waiting for an appointment at the GP. Please let us know if you make use of this service and if it was useful.
